UPDATE ON COVID-19

March 17, 2020

This is an important message from First Selectman Edward Bailey and Emergency Management Director, Robert Poturnicki.

In response to the Coronavirus outbreak (COVID-19) and to help reduce spread of the virus and protect our residents, especially the most vulnerable, the Town has closed and cancelled programs and activities.

As of this date, the following have been closed or cancelled:

- Community Center - Closed to non-government related organizations and activities.
- Senior Center - All activities, including in-house senior lunches.
Box lunches will be available for pickup on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, by calling Sue D'Orvilliers, 860.349.7112, by 12P the day before.
- All Park and Recreation Activities.
- Durham Middlefield Youth and Family Services Activities

As of Thursday, March 19, 2020, the following offices will be modifying operations to appointment-only for essential services:

- **Town Hall.**
- **Community Center.**
- **Public Works.**

Please call the department with which you need to do business. If your request is deemed essential and cannot be conducted electronically or rescheduled for a later date, a staff member will make an appointment for you.
