Meeting Notes:

1. Call to Order  
The meeting was called to order at 4:03 pm by Ken Twombly, Chair.
2. Pledge of Allegiance  
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Approval of the minutes of January 16, 2025: A motion to approve the minutes as presented was made by Fran Gudelski and seconded by John Giammatteo. The motion was approved unanimously with no abstentions.  
Approval of the minutes of February 4, 2025: A motion to approve the minutes as presented was made by Anne Malcolm and seconded by John Giammatteo. The motion was approved unanimously with no abstentions.
4. Public Comment: No public present.

The commission asked Susan McNamara, member of the Board of Finance, to communicate to the Board of Finance that the consensus of the commission is to move forward with exploring the feasibility of acquiring the church property and that the commission may need funding for due diligence investigations. The chair of the commission and the First

Selectman expressed that they would be willing to come to a Board of Finance meeting to further discussion.
