

Warning of State Election

November 5, 2024

The Electors of the Town of Middlefield are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Presidential and Vice-Presidential electors, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, and Judge of Probate.
- II. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of a proposed Amendment to the Constitution of Connecticut, a vote of "Yes" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "No" being a vote for disapproval:
 1. "Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to permit the General Assembly to allow each voter to vote by absentee ballot?"

The full text of such proposed question with explanatory text, printed in accordance with Sec. §2-30a of the General Statutes, is available at the Town Clerk's Office for public distribution.

The vote on the proposed question is taken pursuant to the Constitution of Connecticut.

- III. Pursuant to Section 10-56 of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, as amended, upon a resolution adopted by the Regional School District No. 13 Board of Education at a meeting held on August 29, 2024.

The resolution will be placed on the ballot labels as the following question with a vote of "Yes" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "No" being a vote for disapproval:

1. "Shall Regional School District No. 13, comprised of the Towns of Durham and Middlefield, appropriate \$76,130,000 for the expansion and renovation of Memorial School in Middlefield into a Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 5 school and authorize the issuance of bonds, notes or temporary notes in an amount not to exceed \$39,000,000 to finance the appropriation, or so much as may be necessary after deducting grants to be received for the project?"

- IV. Pursuant to Section 7-191 of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, upon a resolution adopted by the Board of Selectmen at a meeting held on September 3, 2024 the following three (3) questions will be placed on the ballot labels as the following questions, with a vote of "Yes" being a vote for approval, and a vote of "No" being a vote for disapproval:

1. "Shall the proposed amendment to Section 605 removing the requirement that members of the boards and commissions not serve more than three (3) consecutive terms, be adopted?"
2. "Shall the proposed amendment to Section 205 of the Charter be adopted extending the time period for replacement for a member of the Board of Selectmen, in the event of a vacancy on the board, from 30 to 45 days?"
3. "Shall all other of the proposed amendments to the Charter, primarily including corrections to grammar, punctuation and updates reflecting changes in state statutes be adopted?"
